**Please note that the weeks do not need to be sequential. We reserve the right to require a minimal number of registrants per site or an individual, themed camp may be cancelled. Should this occur, you will have the option to change to a different camp or to receive a refund of your tuition payment.

Additional Enrichment for 2019!!! STRENGTHEN MATH SKILLS!!! LEARN CURSIVE!!!

All campers can participate in additional enrichment time in **math** which we will offer every week of camp. This will involve pre-assessment of basic math skills and approximately four hours of math instruction and practice for each camp week.

All campers who are rising 3rd grade or higher can add learning **cursive handwriting**, which we will offer during every week of camp. This will involve approximately three hours of direct instruction and practice in learning to read and write in cursive each camp week.

Each of these learning opportunities is an additional \$10 per camper per week or \$50 per camper for all six weeks (\$20 per week to do both or \$100 per camper to do both for the whole summer). If you pay as you go, or after June 1st, the fees will be \$15 per camper per week for each theme or \$75 per camper for all six weeks (\$30 per week to do both or \$150 for the whole summer). Written Assessment Reports

Each camper who attends all three sessions (six weeks) will be entitled to a written assessment report within 60 days of the conclusion of camp. Campers who attend for shorter periods can obtain a written report for a fee. Please understand that the gathering, analyzing and compiling the relevant information into report form takes a considerable amount of time. Paying for a report such as this with a regular clinician normally costs between \$300 and \$500. We are pleased to offer a comparable service for a much smaller, sliding scale price for those who camp with us for any amount of time...and free for those who camp with us all six weeks.

Early Drop Off and Late Pick-Up Fees

For parents who need to arrive before our 8:30am start time and for those who cannot return before the end of the day at 5:30pm, we can accommodate you. Early drop-off or late pick-up is an additional \$25 per family per week. Early drop-off is from 7:45am to 8:30am. Late pick-up is from 5:30 to 6:15pm. If you arrive before 8:30...even at 8:20, for example, that is still considered early drop-off, even if other children and staff are already at camp. We maintain our child to counselor ratio based on our understanding of times and numbers of children, so please do not assume you can drop off and go if it's not yet 8:30 just because you see staff present. 8:30 is drop-off time. With late pick up, we are happy to stay with campers until a parent or guardian arrives, but our long, wonderfully exhausting camp day ends at 5:30pm. A 5:45 or 6pm arrival that occurs often will entail a fee; we will add this if we wait beyond 5:30 more than twice within a week.

Catered Lunch

Campers have the option of purchasing lunch throughout the week. There is a different offering each day—ranging from soup, salad, sandwich; pizza; burgers and/or hot dogs; chicken tenders; and submarine sandwiches. There are vegetarian choices each day. Lunch for the full week is \$25 per camper. Daily lunch is \$7. You may pay this at camp in one lump sum, weekly, or daily. Please note that after June 1st, a one-time, \$25 per camper registration fee must be added. After June 17th, the fee increases to \$50 per camper. For 2019, there is an additional OUT AND ABOUT FEE assessed for all campers to cover travel and admission costs for field trips and swimming. For each two-week session, it's \$25 per camper; for one week, it's \$15. The OUT AND ABOUT FEE applies to all campers, is due on the first day of the camp session or the first day the camper attends during that session.
